Montpelier Street is well located close to Western Road with its array of shops, restaurants, supermarket and Churchill Square shopping Centre.

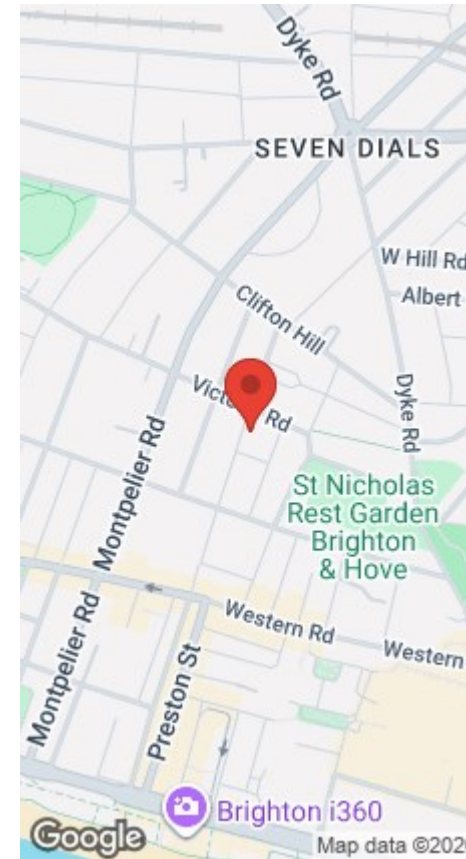
