Spelsbury Cottage is a beautifully refurbished detached Cotswold stone cottage, set in the charming village of Dean. This delightful property seamlessly blends traditional character with modern comforts, offering versatile accommodation arranged over two floors, ideal for family life or a tranquil rural retreat.

Upon entering, you are welcomed into a hallway leading to the principal reception rooms, including a dining room featuring an open fireplace, ideal for cosy meals and entertaining. The sitting room boasts a traditional woodburner, creating a warm and inviting space for relaxation and enjoying the character of the property.

At the back of the house sits a well-equipped kitchen, fitted with a cooker and fridge/freezer, providing a practical and inviting space for everyday living. Adjacent to the kitchen, a utility room houses a washing machine and dryer, offering added convenience. On the ground floor, there is also a modern shower room, perfectly suited for family or guest use.
