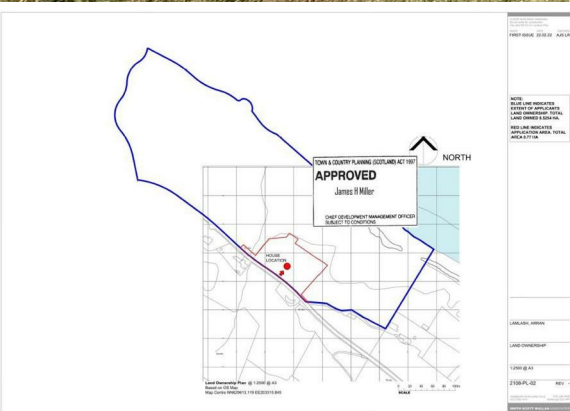

The land is a short distance out of the village of Lamlash on the road to Whiting Bay which is locally known as The Heights.

The proposed new build has planning approval for its own new road access and is on a designated 5 acre site within the 20 acres.

Whiting Bay is a bustling and friendly community with a large village hall, local pub, restaurants, excellent shops, an 18 hole golf course and bowling green amongst many other amenities - it has a beautiful sandy beach and has easy access to the many forestry and country walks nearby at the picturesque Glenashdale and Fairy Glen.
