



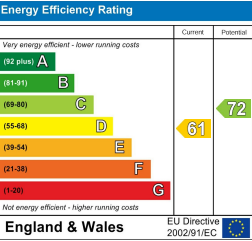

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In Detail

A generously proportioned three bedroom mid-century townhouse forming part of a community-orientated cul de sac directly next to Westow Park.

This property boasts light and bright accommodation arranged over three levels and includes a separate outbuilding with a toilet and kitchenette - a serious advantage for a professional home worker seeking a quiet and comfortable space. The entrance level comprises of a 26ft kitchen / diner which offers an abundance of work and storage space, complete with a separate utility room, and lending well to culinary enthusiasts or those who enjoy entertaining - particularly as a separate WC negates the need to go upstairs. The first floor is a 26ft reception area with large windows which allow for lots of natural light, a sit-up wet bar, and sliding to doors to outside. The top floor houses three bedrooms and a smart shower room with a rainfall shower.

Externally the garden has been landscaped to include a decked seating area with lighting, potted plants and shrubbery which add pops of colour, a further 25ft outbuilding (ideal for storage), and a sunny south easterly aspect. There is off street parking at the front of the house, whilst being the very first on the cul de sac allows for a wider plot and more space.

This superb marketing offering is well placed for access to central Crystal Palace and both Gipsy Hill and Crystal Palace rail links. If schools are a consideration then nearby highly regarded primaries include Paxton, Rockmount, and Cypress.
