Floorplan

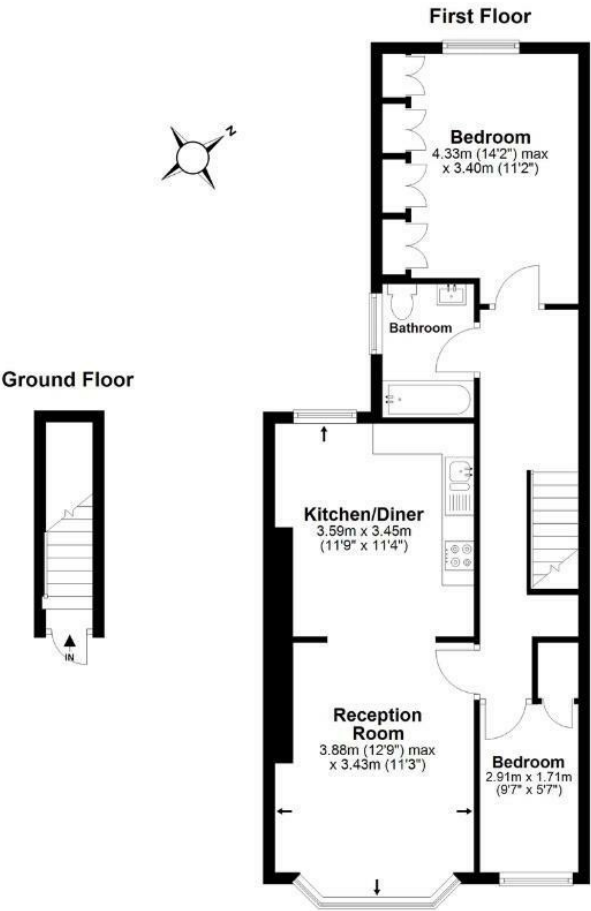

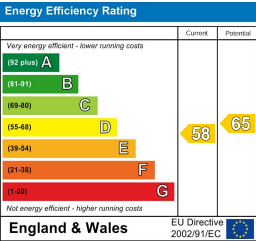
