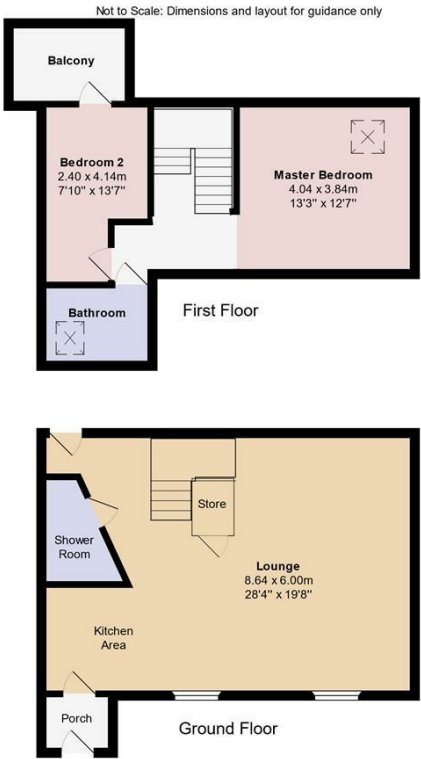
Outside, there are two allocated parking spaces to the rear of the building, with access through a secure, communal entrance hall.
