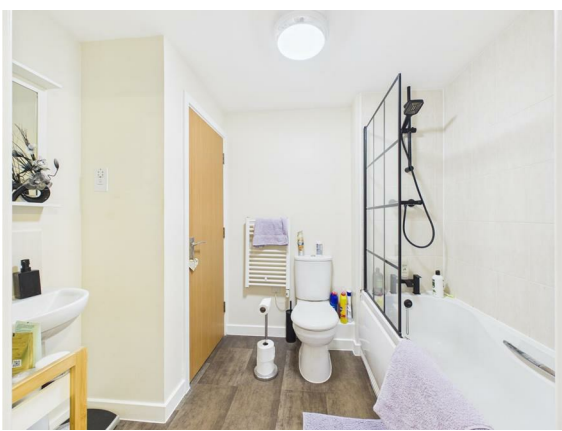
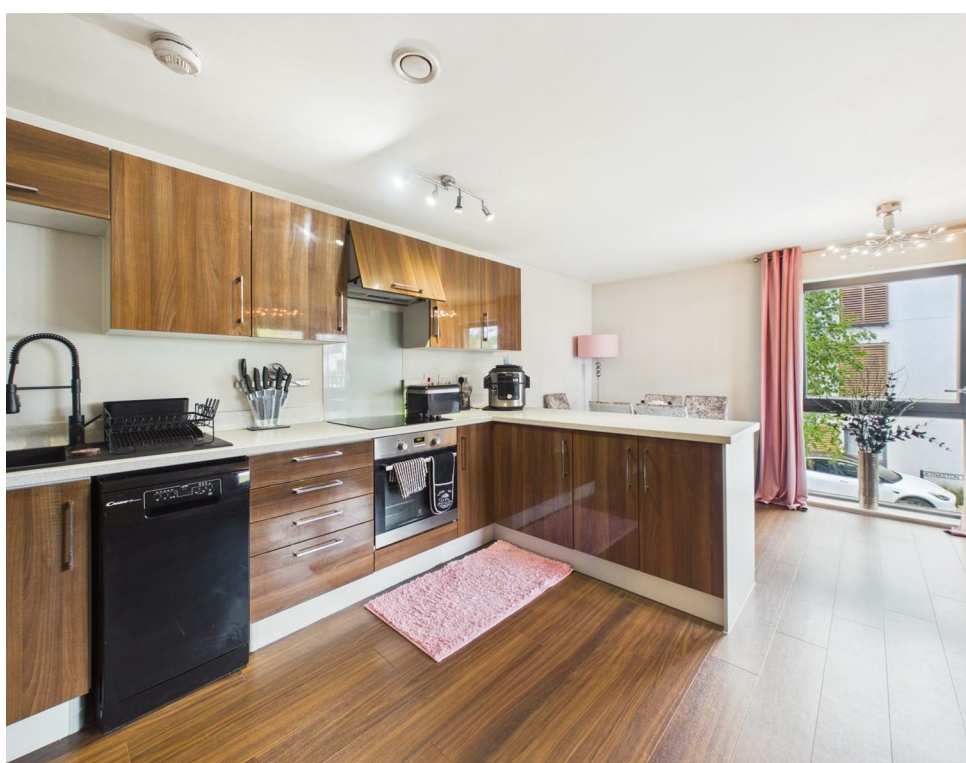
The property features a bright open-plan living area, combining a modern fitted kitchen with a dining and lounge space.

The main Eco features of the Hanham Hall properties is they are Incredibly well insulated SIP walls (including soundproofing on party walls) and floors, with a mechanical ventilation & heat recovery unit (MHRU) so you don't lose any heat unless you open a window. Solar panels on the roof cut down electricity bills. The rainwater harvesting (RWH) system from the roofs uses 'grey water' for your washing machine to help reduce your water bill. A SUDS system is designed to collect surface water from roads and pathways and channel it through swales into the wildlife pond by the playgrounds.
